As students work individually and independently within their assignment tasks (documented in their Art or Photography handbook) the work set is usually individualized and through discussion with their Art tutor. Some learning will done outside of the lesson time, so that students have more opportunities and access to a variety of media. Specific work will also be set to build skills and confidence in types of media that the students can use at home.	All GCSE coursework and homework is completed in their sketchbooks.	As verbal feedback is the most effective form of feedback, this will be given regularly to students within their lessons. Detailed and relevant feedback is given at certain points within their assignment period.
