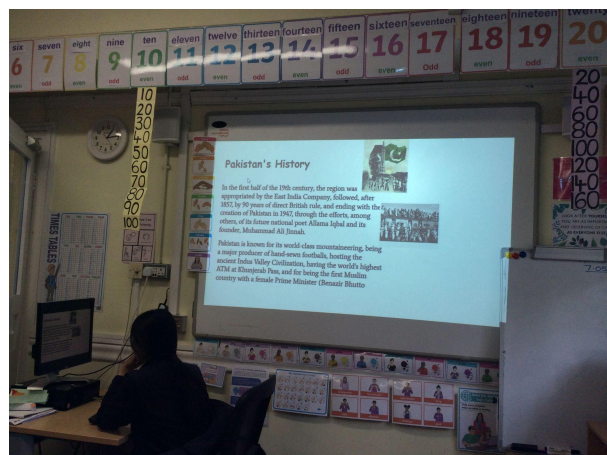


Shout out to lessons in school this week!

Connaught Goes Out 2026

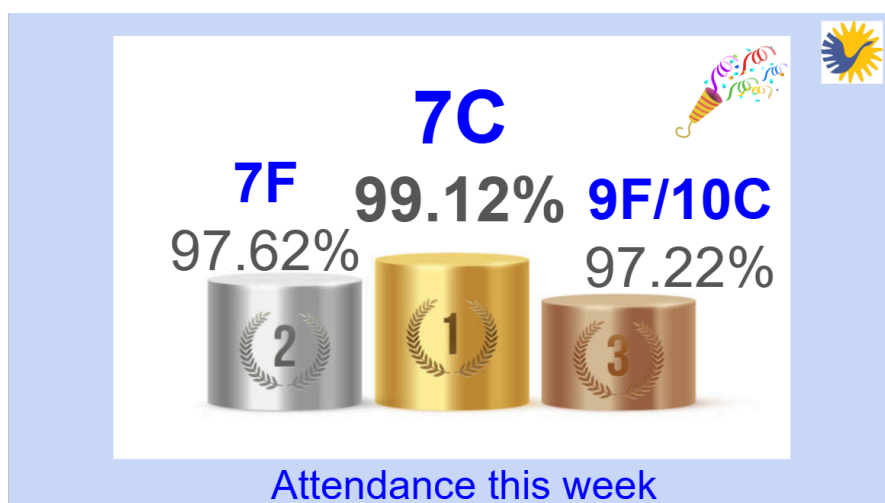
