**Re: GCSE Results Day and Appeals**

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the collection of GCSE results and to inform you of the appeals process.

GCSE results can only be collected **in person** from 09:00 on Thursday 20th August 2026 from the school dining hall. Our Connaught Road playground gates will be open on this day. This will be the only entrance for students to collect results.

If students or their parents/carers wish someone else to collect their results for them, they must email from their student email account [exams@connaught.waltham.sch.uk](mailto:exams@connaught.waltham.sch.uk) with the name of the person who will collect the results. The person collecting the results **must bring photographic identification**. Results which are not collected will be posted on results day to the home address we have on file.

There will be Chromebooks available in the school hall for students wishing to enrol at colleges electronically and quickly.

**The GCSE grades awarded will give you the opportunity to move on to college or sixth form. We strongly advise you to contact the colleges you have applied to with your grades to confirm your place for next year as soon as you collect your results. If you are unhappy with any of your GCSE grades but still have secured a place at the college you wish to attend and study the courses you have applied for, we strongly advise you take up your place at the college of your choice.**
